STATE OF MINNESOTA IN SUPREME COURT

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. §480.22 authorizes the Minnesota Supreme Court to designate the location of chambers for judges of all courts in the state after consultation with the judges of the affected district;

WHEREAS, the district judges of the Seventh Judicial District on May 4, 1983 requested that the chambers of the Honorable Roger M. Klaphake be moved from Little Falls to St. Cloud;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has consulted with the judges of the Seventh Judicial District with respect to the said chambers location; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has studied the workload distribution, the assignment schedule, and judicial travel requirements of the district court of the Seventh Judicial District;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the permanent chambers of the Honorable Roger M. Klaphake be located in the city of St. Cloud.
