## Dear Counsel:

Jeffrey S. Berg, et al., have filed a motion requesting that Chief Justice Kathleen Blatz assign a single judge to hear 23 pending declaratory judgment actions brought by Twin Cities Harley-Davidson, Inc. For purposes of this motion these cases have been assigned the title In Re Twin Cities Harley-Davidson Litigation and assigned the case number referenced above.
