

STATE OF MINNESOTA IN SUPREME COURT C9-85-1506

ORDER

In Re Judicial Vacancy and Rechambering Tenth Judicial District

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 480.22 the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of chambers of judges;

WHEREAS, the Honorable James B. Gunderson has been granted retirement effective November 12, 1997;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has received a request from the Chief Judge of the Tenth Judicial District that the chambers of the Honorable James R. Clifford be moved from Pine City in Pine County to Center City in Chisago County;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has considered the weighted caseload information regarding the relative judicial needs of the Tenth Judicial District and the views of the Tenth Judicial District judges;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The vacancy created by the Honorable James B. Gunderson's retirement be and hereby is certified to the Governor to be chambered at Pine City in Pine County and to be filled in the manner provided by law; and
- 2. The chambers of the Honorable James R. Clifford be, and hereby are, moved from Pine County to Chisago County effective upon the assumption of office by the person appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by Judge Gunderson's retirement.
