ORDER

WHEREAS, under Minnesota Statutes 480.22 (2000), the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of judges' chambers;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Kenneth Maas will reach mandatory retirement April 30, 2002;

- 2. The chambers of the Honorable Gary J. Meyer be, and hereby are, moved from Wright County to Washington County effective upon the assumption of office by the person appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by the Honorable Kenneth Maas' retirement.
