

STATE OF MINNESOTA IN SUPREME COURT C9-85-1506

ORDER

In Re Judicial Vacancy and Rechambering First Judicial District

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 480.22 the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of chambers of judges;

WHEREAS, the Honorable John M. Fitzgerald reaches mandatory retirement age of 70 on January 20, 1993, and must retire on January 31, 1993;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has received a request from the Chief Judge of the First Judicial District that the chambers of the Honorable Richard G. Spicer be moved from Chaska in Carver County to Hastings in Dakota County;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has considered the weighted caseload information regarding the relative judicial needs of the First Judicial District and the views of the First Judicial District judges;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The vacancy created by the Honorable John M. Fitzgerald's retirement be and hereby is certified to the Governor to be chambered at Chaska in Carver County and to be filled in the manner provided by law; and
- 2. The chambers of the Honorable Richard G. Spicer be, and hereby are, moved from Carver County to Dakota County effective upon the assumption of office by the person appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by Judge Fitzgerald's retirement.
