ORDER

In Re Judicial Vacancy and Rechambering Third Judicial District

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 480.22 the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of chambers of judges;

WHEREAS, the death of the Honorable Harold O. Krieger created a vacancy on April 22, 1995;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has received a request from the Honorable James L. Mork that his chambers be moved from Austin in Mower County to Rochester in Olmsted County;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has consulted with the judges of the Third Judicial District and has considered the weighted caseload information regarding the relative judicial needs of the Third Judicial District;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The vacancy created by the death of the Honorable Harold O. Krieger be and hereby is certified to the Governor to be chambered at Austin in Mower County and to be filled in the manner provided by law; and
- 2. The chambers of the Honorable James L. Mork be, and hereby are, moved from Mower County to Olmsted County effective June 1, 1995.
