WHEREAS, under Minnesota Statutes 480.22 (2000), the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of judges' chambers;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mary E. Carlson has resigned as a judge of the Tenth Judicial District, effective June 13, 2004;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has received a request from the Honorable Gregory G. Galler of the Tenth Judicial District that his chambers be moved from Elk River in Sherburne County to Stillwater in Washington County;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has considered the weighted caseload information regarding the relative judicial needs of the Tenth Judicial District and the views of the Tenth Judicial District judges;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The vacancy created by the Honorable Mary E. Carlson's resignation be, and hereby is, certified to the Governor to be chambered at Elk River in Sherburne County and to be filled in the manner provided by law; and
- 2. The chambers of the Honorable Gregory E. Galler J. Meyer be, and hereby are, moved from Sherburne County to Washington County effective upon the assumption of office by the person appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by the Honorable Mary E. Carlson's resignation.
