ORDER

WHEREAS, under Minnesota Statutes 480.22 (2000), the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of judges' chambers;

WHEREAS, the Honorable William Walker has retired as a judge of the Seventh Judicial District, effective December 9, 2005;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has received a request from the Honorable John E. Pearson of the Seventh Judicial District that his chambers be moved from Moorhead in Clay County to Detroit Lakes in Becker County;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has considered the weighted caseload information regarding the relative judicial needs of the Seventh Judicial District and the views of the Seventh Judicial District judges;

## NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- The vacancy created by the Honorable William Walker's retirement be, and hereby is, certified to the Governor to be chambered at Moorhead in Clay County and to be filled in the manner provided by law; and
- 2. The chambers of the Honorable John E. Pearson be, and hereby are, moved from Clay County to Becker County effective upon the assumption of office by the person appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by the Honorable William Walker's retirement.
