ORDER

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 480.22, the Supreme Court is authorized to designate the location of judges' chambers; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Jean A. Davies of the First Judicial District, died on March 25, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has received a request from the Honorable Richard C. Perkins of the First Judicial District that his chambers be moved from LeCenter in LeSueur County to Chaska in Carver County; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has considered the weighted caseload information regarding the relative judicial needs of the First Judicial District and the views of the First Judicial District judges;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The vacancy created by the death of the Honorable Jean A. Davies be, and hereby is, certified to the Governor to be chambered at LeCenter in LeSueur County and to be filled in the manner provided by law; and
2. The chambers of the Honorable Richard C. Perkins be, and hereby are, moved from LeSueur County to Carver County effective upon the assumption of office by the person appointed to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of the Honorable Jean A. Davies.


