THIRD ORDER AMENDING MEMBERSHIP OF MINNESOTA SUPREME COURT JUVENILE JUSTICE SERVICES TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, on September 27, 1999, this Court issued an Order establishing the Minnesota Supreme Court Juvenile Justice Services Task Force for the purpose of:

- Identifying in designated counties the existing services and collaboratives (a) available to address the needs of families involved in delinquency and status offense cases;
- Identifying gaps and overlaps regarding services and collaboratives on a statewide (b) basis:
- (c) Identifying barriers to improved collaboration on a statewide basis:
- Developing model protocols to provide optimum service statewide: (d)
- (e) Developing outcome measures by which the effectiveness of juvenile services programs can be monitored;
- Making recommendations regarding service gaps, overlaps, and barriers to (f) coordinated services;
- Developing a uniform list of possible Out-of-Home Placement goals for juvenile (g) court dispositions from which judges could select when complying with Minn. Stat. § 260.181, subd. 3; and
- Identifying steps required by state agencies to collect and report summary (h) information on the achievement of the established goals; and

WHEREAS, Joe Heinz, Director of Hennepin County Juvenile Probation, was appointed as a member of the Juvenile Justice Services Task Force and is leaving his position.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that after due consideration the membership of the Juvenile Justice Services Task Force is amended to replace Joe Heinz with Michael Belton, Director of Hennepin County Juvenile Probation.
