ORDER EXTENDING PILOT PROJECT

ON OPEN HEARINGS IN JUVENILE

PROTECTION MATTERS

By Order filed January 22, 1998, the Supreme Court established a three-year pilot

project authorizing open hearings in juvenile protection proceedings. The pilot project

commenced June 22, 1998.

By the same Order, the Court directed that an independent research organization

conduct an evaluation of the pilot project and file a report addressing the impact of open

hearings and records. The State Court Administrator contracted with the National Center

for State Courts (NCSC) to conduct the evaluation. The NCSC is scheduled to submit its

report by July 31, 2001. Upon submission of the NCSC Open Hearings Evaluation Report

the Court intends to publish the report and issue an order setting the matter for public

hearing.

By virtue of an under the inherent power and statutory authority of the Minnesota

Supreme Court to regulate public access to records and proceedings of the judicial branch,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The Open Hearings Pilot Project shall continue through December 31, 2001, or until

further order of the Court, which ever occurs first.
