




WHEREAS, the Special Committee on Juvenile Court Rules of the Minnesota Juvenile Judges Association has adopted the following resolution:

The Special Committee on Juvenile Court Rules of Procedure recommends that the Minnesota County Court Judges Association, acting through its Executive Committee, request that the Supreme Court of Minnesota take immediate steps for the drafting and formal promulgation of Uniform Rules of Procedure for all Juvenile Court proceedings in the State of Minnesota and further; that, in accordance therewith should the Supreme Court appoint an Advisory Committee for the purpose of drafting such Rules ~~at least one half of the membership of such~~ Committee be judges who regularly exercise jurisdiction in juvenile proceedings.

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee of the Minnesota County Judges Association has adopted said resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, The Minnesota County Judges Association respectfully requests the Minnesota Supreme Court to proceed according to said resolution.
