

WHEREAS, Certain money has and in the future will come into the possession of the clerk of this court under and pursuant to the order of this court dated October 5, 1961, providing for the annual registration of all attorneys at law authorized to practice in this state;

NOW, THEREFORE, It is hereby ordered:


1. That all money so received by the clerk of this court shall be deposited in Northwestern National Bank, St. Paul, Minnesota, in a special account in the name of the Supreme Court of the State of Minnesota.
2. That all money so deposited shall be subject to withdrawal for the payment of expenses incident to the admission of attorneys to practice law in this state and for the conduct of disciplinary proceedings by check signed by the clerk of said court and countersigned by an authorized member of the supreme court.
3. That the clerk of this court shall file a fidelity bond in the principal amount of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) conditioned upon the payment of money so received into the designated bank, the premium for which shall be paid out of funds received as an expense of administration.
4. That all moneys received by the Board of Law Examiners or its Director from applicants for admission to the practice of law shall be deposited with the State Treasurer of the State of Minnesota and withdrawn as provided by Minn. St. 481.01.
