ORDER AUTHORIZING DISCLOSURE
OF ATTORNEY ADDRESSES FOR
JUDICIAL EVALUATION PROGRAM

Rule 9 of the Rules of the Supreme Court for Registration of Attorneys limits disclosure of attorney addresses and registration numbers from the attorney registration database, and courts and the judicial districts are in need of current addresses and registration numbers to carry out judicial evaluation programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Rule 9 of the Rules of the Supreme Court for Registration of Attorneys is amended as follows (additions are shown by underlined text):


C. **Lists Available to Continuing Legal Education Providers and the Courts**. Upon written request and payment of the required fee, the Clerk may disclose to a bona fide continuing legal education business a complete list of the name, address, admission date, continuing legal education category, current status, and license number of all registered attorneys. The Clerk may also disclose the same information to a court or judicial district solely for use in updating mailing addresses of attorneys to be included in a judicial evaluation program.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this amendment shall be effective immediately.
