ORDER POSTPONING HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE MINNESOTA RULES FOR REGISTRATION OF ATTORNEYS

In an order filed on September 30, 2005 this Court set a hearing for January 25, 2006 to consider the petition of the Minnesota State Bar Association to amend the Minnesota Rules for Registration of Attorneys to require lawyers to report whether they carry malpractice insurance.

This Court has been advised that proposed revisions to the Rules for Registration of Attorneys will soon be filed by a working group made up of administrators from the Board of Law Examiners, Office of Lawyers Professional Responsibility, and the Clerk of Appellate Courts. This Court has concluded that it would be advantageous to consider both proposals at one hearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the January 25, 2006 hearing is postponed. A new hearing date will be set once the second rules amendment proposal is filed with this Court.
