IN SUPREME COURT

IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph 3 of Rule IX of the Rules of the Supreme Court for Admission to the Bar effective August 1, 1959, be amended to read as follows:

"3. The Supreme Court shall appoint annually a Review Committee consisting of three members of the State Board of Law Examiners. The examination papers of not less than the top 20% of the applicants who fail to achieve a passing grade on the initial examination of their papers shall be referred to the Review Committee for review and grading without prior knowledge of the grades assigned on the initial examination of these papers. An applicant shall be considered as having passed the examination if his final grade as determined by the Review Committee is equal to or exceeds the minimum satisfactory grade fixed by the State Board of Law Examiners."

This amendment is effective immediately.
