PROMULGATION OF AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES ON LAWYERS PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY

WHEREAS, on June 13, 1996, this Court promulgated amendments to the Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility, and

WHEREAS, the Lawyers Professional Responsibility Board has now recommended additional technical amendments to Rules 9(b) and Rule 30, and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has reviewed the recommendations and is fully advised in the premises,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. Rule 9(b) is repealed amended as follows:
 - (b) Admission of Charges. The lawyer may, if so desired:
 - (1) aAdmit some or all charges; or.
 - (2) Tender an admission of some or all charged conditioned upon a stated

disposition:

If a lawyer makes such an admission or tender, the Director may proceed under Rule Rule 10(b)

- Rule 30, Administrative Supervision Suspension is added as follows:
 Rule 30, Rules on Lawyers Professional Responsibility Administrative Suspension
- 3. These amendments shall become effective this date.
