IN RE APPOINTMENTS TO THE
LEGAL SERVICES FUNDING COMMITTEE

ORDER

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Planning Agency has identified a multi-million dollar funding gap between spending and revenue in future biennia through June, 2005;

WHEREAS, the federal government is likely to shift funding responsibility for many federally funded programs to the state and to cut significantly funding for many programs;

WHEREAS, the state should be prepared with an action plan for addressing service delivery in critically affected areas;

WHEREAS, the legislature has requested the court to convene a joint committee to address the means of meeting the critical civil legal needs of low income persons in this environment;


