APPENDIX TO RULE 15 – APPENDIX B

As of May 20, 2023, the sentence for a gross misdemeanor in Minnesota is now

imprisonment for not more than 364 days, and the sentence for a felony is imprisonment for

one year/365 days or more. See Act of May 19, 2023, ch. 52, art 6, §§ 4-6. As a result of

this change, form Appendix B to Rule 15 of the Minnesota Rules of Criminal Procedure

requires amending. That form concerns a misdemeanor/gross misdemeanor petition to enter

a plea of guilty and states that the maximum possible sentence for any gross misdemeanor

offense is 1 year imprisonment, but the maximum possible sentence for a gross misdemeanor

is now 364 days.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the amendment to form Appendix B to Rule 15 of

the Minnesota Rules of Criminal Procedure is prescribed and promulgated to be effective

immediately. The amendment to the form as approved is attached to this order.
