**ORDER REGARDING PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED
AMENDMENTS TO THE MINNESOTA RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE**

O R D E R

The Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the Rules of Civil Procedure has recommended amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure to clarify the operation of some rules and establish procedures for rejection of documents that contain restricted identifiers or other non-public information. In an order filed on June 28, 2019, we invited public comments and scheduled a public hearing for September 25, 2019, directing those who wished to speak at the hearing to file a request to do so before the close of the comment period. Seven written comments were filed by August 27, which included one request to speak at the September 25 hearing. The request to speak at the hearing included comments and materials in support of the committee's recommended amendment to Rule 67.02 of the Rules of Civil Procedure. After review of the comments, it appears that a public hearing on the recommended amendments to the Rules of Civil Procedure is not necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the public hearing scheduled for September 25, 2019, on the proposed amendments to the Minnesota Rules of Civil Procedure be, and the same is, cancelled.
