ORDER SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF CIVIL APPELLATE PROCEDURE

In an order filed on November 13, 2018, we directed the Advisory Committee for the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure to review the requirements for the use and preparation of transcripts for the record on appeal, which includes the "transcription of any testimony given by audiotape, videotape, or other electronic means" that has not been previously transcribed. *See* Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 110.02, subd.4. In a report filed on April 1, 2019, the committee recommended that no further amendments be made to Minn. R. Civ. App. P. 110.02, subd. 4. We opened a public comment period on April 25, 2019, which closed on June 25, 2019, with one written comment filed. After further consideration, including review of the written comments filed with respect to the recommended amendments to the Rules of Criminal Procedure that govern transcript use and preparation in criminal proceedings, we have decided that a public hearing will assist the court's consideration of and decision on the committee's recommendation.

Based on all the files, records, and proceedings herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a hearing will be held before this court to consider the recommendation of the Advisory Committee for the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure. The hearing will be held on September 25, 2019, in the Supreme Court Courtroom, State Capitol, Saint Paul, Minnesota, at 10:00 a.m. The chair of the Supreme Court Advisory Committee for the Rules of Civil Appellate Procedure, or the chair's designee, is invited to present the committee's recommendations.
