**ORDER REGARDING PUBLIC HEARING  
ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE  
GENERAL RULES OF PRACTICE**

The Minnesota Supreme Court Alternative Dispute Resolution Ethics Board has filed a report that recommends amendments to Rule 114 of the General Rules of Practice, which governs alternative dispute resolution and the neutrals who provide alternative dispute resolution services. By order filed September 29, 2017, the court opened a public comment period and scheduled a public hearing on the proposed amendments to the Rule 114 of the General Rules of Practice for December 19, 2017, at 11:00 a.m.

Based on the report, written comments, and requests to speak,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the December 19 hearing shall proceed as follows:

1. Referee Richard Stebbins, member of the Supreme Court Alternative Dispute Resolution Ethics Board, shall have up to 15 minutes of time to present the report and recommendations of the Alternative Dispute Resolution Ethics Board.
2. Representatives of the ADR Section of the Minnesota State Bar Association, the Construction Law Section of the Minnesota State Bar Association, and the Family Law Section of the Minnesota State Bar Association shall each have up to 10 minutes to present their respective comments.

3. Alex Glassman and Mary Catherine Lauhead shall each have 5 minutes to present their respective comments.
