**ORDER REGARDING PUBLIC HEARING
ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE
GENERAL RULES OF PRACTICE**

On November 30, 2016, the Minnesota Tribal Court/State Court Forum filed a petition that proposes amendments to Rule 10 of the General Rules of Practice for the District Courts, which governs the recognition of Tribal Court orders and judgments in district court proceedings. We referred the petition to the Minnesota Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the General Rules of Practice, which filed a report with recommended amendments to Rule 10 on October 27, 2017. We opened a public comment period and also scheduled a public hearing, on March 14, 2018 at 9:00 a.m., on the recommended amendments. Written comments have been filed and five requests to speak at the hearing have been filed.

Based on the report, written comments, and requests to speak,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the hearing on March 14 shall proceed as follows.

2. The Honorable John P. Smith, Senior Judge, Minnesota Court of Appeals, the Honorable Korey Wahwassuck, Ninth Judicial District, the Honorable Sally L. Tarnowski,

Sixth Judicial District, George Soule, and Jessica Ryan, shall each have up to 10 minutes of time to present their respective comments.
