ORDER REGARDING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE MINNESOTA RULES OF JUVENILE PROTECTION PROCEDURE AND THE MINNESOTA RULES OF ADOPTION PROCEDURE

The Advisory Committee for the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure and the Rules of Adoption Procedure has recommended amendments to those rules to make necessary changes to the rules in light of changes and amendments to the Indian Child Welfare Act and related laws and regulations; and additional amendments that will facilitate the use of the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure by judges and practitioners. In an order filed on December 20, 2018, we opened a public comment period, scheduled a public hearing on March 27, 2019, and directed those who wanted to appear at the March 27 hearing to file a request to do so. No public comments or requests to appear at the March 27 hearing were filed as of the close of the comment period on February 19, 2019.

Based on all the files, records, and proceedings herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the public hearing scheduled for March 27, 2019 on the proposed amendments to the Rules of Juvenile Protection Procedure and the Rules of Adoption Procedure be, and the same is, cancelled.
