FINANCIAL EARLY NEUTRAL EVALUATION

(For attorneys and accountants with five years or more of family law experience)

Parties with one or more financial issues with the expectation that if the parties have the neutral information, they will better be able to reach an early settlement before the parties' financial resources are expended on litigation. When parties are able to weigh the costs of pursuing adversarial evaluations and litigating financial issues versus an efficient, economical settlement early in the case, most parties favor the early settlement.
