Sharon, Norrine, and John Nelson (SNJ) file this response jointly and we stand firm on our opposition of the fee submissions of Cozen O'Connor and Justin Bruntjen. As our prior legal counsel has detailed, which we refer the Court to our prior submissions, we strongly object to the amounts of legal fees submitted by Cozen O'Connor and Justin Bruntjen. We feel that the compensation sought is excessive given the amount of work completed, which did not benefit the estate. Furthermore, these lawyers have no meaningful entertainment experience and added no value. In our opinion, these lawyers did nothing more than escalate unnecessary fees and contribute to division amongst the heirs.
