Open Meeting and Closed Sessions Policy

I. POLICY STATEMENT

The meetings of the Judicial Council are presumed to be open to the public. On a case by case determination, by majority vote, the Judicial Council may close meetings or portions of meetings to discuss management positions in personnel matters, labor negotiations or litigation strategy with counsel, or other matters requiring confidentiality. A motion to close shall specifically identify the reason and be recorded in the minutes.
