# **COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing Policy**

## I. POLICY STATEMENT

Unless the United States Supreme Court concludes the program is invalid or delays implementation, it is the policy of the Minnesota Judicial Branch to implement the COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing Emergency Temporary Standards<sup>[1]</sup> (ETS) issued by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) by requiring full vaccination no later than January 10, 2022, or weekly testing and wearing a face covering at all times according to the ETS for those not fully vaccinated thereafter.

### **II. IMPLEMENTATION AUTHORITY**

Implementation of this policy shall be the responsibility of the State Court Administrator, acting as the Judicial Council's agent.
