When: Friday, April 29, 2016, 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Where: Anoka County Courthouse, Law Library E130

Legal documents and court forms will be provided at no charge. If the family form is complete, court dates will be given and copies, envelopes, and stamps for mailing will be given at no charge.

Free Legal Advice:

There will be attorneys available for one-on-one consultations regarding family law issues. Each appointment will be approximately 20 minutes. Walk-ins are welcome and will be seen on a first come-first serve basis; appointments can be made in advance by calling (763) 422-7563. Assistance with court forms will be available during the clinic. There are no income eligibility requirements – the clinics are free to all persons.

Family issues:

Attorneys will be available to discuss issues surrounding child support, driver's license payment plans for child support, custody, parenting time, paternity, contempt, divorce, domestic violence, waiver of court fees and costs, order enforcement, proper service, establishing court hearing dates, and other family matters that may come up after a divorce.
