

Odyssey Integration Scenario 4 Disposition Notifications

Notification Events: Disposition Added, Disposition Modified, Disposition Amended, Disposition Amendment Deleted, Disposition Deleted

Sample Case: 87-CR-07-Scenario4

Defendant Name: Clanry Ogavitz (This is a made-up name; any similarity to an existing person is purely coincidental.)

XML Messages – see the accompanying messages that come out of the notification process after each step is completed in Odyssey.

Step	Description	Notes
A	Case initiated with one charge. Count #1 = Loitering with Intent to Participate in Prostitution	Case Initiated Notification Event includes one charge element. Charge Sequence ID = 1.
B	Disposition of “convicted” added	Disposition Added Notification Event includes one charge disposition element, one charge element and one disposition event element.
C	Disposition from Step B amended to “continued for dismissal”	Disposition Amended Notification Event one charge element. Charge Sequence ID = 1
D	Disposition from Step B modified to “dismissed, mentally incompetent”	Disposition Modified Notification Event includes one charge disposition element, one charge element and one disposition event element.
E	Disposition deleted	Disposition Amendment Deleted AND Disposition Deleted AND Charge Modified Notification Events includes one charge disposition element, one charge element and one disposition event element. Note: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In Odyssey, since charge 1 has an original disposition and an amended disposition, you first delete the amended disposition, and then you delete the original disposition. You can either do this all at once and then save the case (one notification will be triggered), or you can do it in two steps,

		<p>saving the case in between (Two notifications will be triggered).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Deleting a disposition results in a Charge Modified notification event, as well as a Disposition Deleted notification event.
