ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY 24

WAIVER OF THE FILING OF ANNUAL REPORTS FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNDER PUBLIC GUARDIANSHIP OR CONSERVATORSHIP AND ARE WARDS OR CONSERVATEES OF THE COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN SERVICES

Minnesota Statute 525.58, subd. 4 requires the filing with the Court of an annual report by the guardian or conservator of the person within thirty (30) days of the anniversary of the appointment of the guardian or conservator and authorizes the Court to expressly waive the filing of such report.

Minnesota Statute 252A.16 requires the preparation of said annual reviews for individuals who are wards or conservatees of the Commissioner of Human Services.

Pursuant to M.S. 525.58, subd. 4, the Eighth Judicial District Judges voted unanimously at their meeting on May 5, 1995 to waive the filing of annual reports required by M.S. 252A.16 for all public guardianships or conservatorships for wards or conservatees of the Commissioner of Human Services.
