ORDER

WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections has a policy that prevents certain inmates from participating in some programs when the inmate is subject to a concurrent misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor sentence, and;

WHEREAS, the judges of the First Judicial District have considered the policy of the Department of Corrections and its effect on persons sentenced by courts in the First Judicial District,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that when a defendant is sentenced to a misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor sentence which is to run concurrently with a felony sentence that the defendant is serving, the existence of the misdemeanor or gross misdemeanor sentence shall not be lodged as a detainer against the defendant or otherwise have any affect on programming decisions of the Department of Corrections with respect to the felony sentence unless otherwise specified by the sentencing judge.
