Standing Order re Expanding the Jail Diversion Program to include certain nontargeted Minneapolis misdemeanor Offenders with warrants for missing court

The Hennepin County Sheriff's Office is hereby given authority to release a person booked into the Hennepin County Jail on a bench warrant for a missed court appearance for an offense from the City of Minneapolis where both the person and the offense meet the criteria for participating in Jail Diversion Program and the person voluntary agrees to social services offered, the following will occur:

- 1. If the person has no other holds and/or warrants, they will have an expedited release without bail on the Minneapolis offense. The Minneapolis warrant will be quashed.
- 2. The person will be provided a court hearing date within 5 business days on the Minneapolis Out of Custody Calendar.
- 3. The person will be transported from the Hennepin County Jail by the Behavioral Health Center staff to the Behavioral Health Center located at 1800 Chicago Ave, Minneapolis, Minnesota.
