4. Governor's Task Force on Child Protection – Referee Moses

The Committee approved Christy Snow-Kaster's request to have the Civil Committee solicit comments and draft feedback on proposed changes to child protection statutes and rules. Referee Moses and Angela Willms will assist Christy with a final draft that will be sent to FVCC voting members for approval.

5. Violent Crime Hotspots – Michelle Jacobson

The Minneapolis Police Department received Byrne grant money to do a one year study to gather data that identifies what makes a specific area a hotspot. The Mayor's office is funding a north Minneapolis pilot outreach program that provides intervention to families at hotspot addresses where there are 911 calls related to domestic violence and no follow-up police report.

6. 2015 proposed Strategic Plan- Judge Cutter and Referee Moses

With the approval of the Committee, Judge Cutter and Referee Moses will draft a goal surrounding prevention. Once approved by the Committee, it will be added to the Strategic Plan.
