IN RE RELEASE OF DEFENDANTS DETAINED ON  
COMPLAINT/WARRANTS BEFORE THE DEFENDANTS' **STANDING ORDER**  
FIRST COURT APPEARANCE

---

The following Order applies to the release of defendants on complaint-warrants or complaint-orders-of-detention before the defendants' first court appearance:

1. Upon posting the cash bail or surety bond specified in a warrant or order-of-detention, the Hennepin County Adult Detention Center (HCADC) must release the defendant without requiring Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (DOCCR) review or authorization. Any nonmonetary conditions of release specified in the complaint/warrant shall be in effect, although not monitored by DOCCR.
2. Upon authorization of the defendants' release by the Department of Community Corrections and Rehabilitation (DOCCR) per Judge Mabley's Order posted at [http://www.mncourts.gov/mncourtsgov/media/fourth\\_district/documents/Orders/CRM-Pre-Appearance-Release-by-DOCCR-2-19-16\\_1.pdf](http://www.mncourts.gov/mncourtsgov/media/fourth_district/documents/Orders/CRM-Pre-Appearance-Release-by-DOCCR-2-19-16_1.pdf), HCADC must release the defendants without requiring them to post the bail or surety bond specified on the complaint-warrant or complaint-order-of-detention.
