PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, pursuant to Minn. Stat. §144.225, subd. 2, and the jurisdiction accorded this Court by Minn. Stat. §260B.101 over children who are delinquent:

BASED ON THE FINDING that it is necessary that the Commissioner of Health provide birth records classified as confidential data under Minn. Stat. §144.225, subd. 2(a) because that data pertains to the birth of children whose mothers were not married to the child's father when the child was conceived nor when the child was born, to enable the Hennepin County Department of Corrections to comply with Hennepin County Juvenile Court orders regarding placing children in certain Out of Home Placement programs and/or facilities that require certified birth certificates as part of their intake procedures.

The Court hereby issues the following:

ORDER

- 1. Upon request, the Minnesota Department of Health shall provide a certified birth record to the Hennepin County Department of Community Corrections for a child who has been ordered by the Hennepin County Juvenile Court to be placed in Out of Home Placement and whose mother falls within the description found in Minn. Stat. §144.225, subd. 2(a).
- 2. Any request for birth information on said child shall be submitted to the Minnesota Department of Health by the Hennepin County Department of Corrections Juvenile Probation Officer assigned to the delinquency matter according to procedures established by the Minnesota Department of Health.
- 3. The confidentiality of information received by the Hennepin County Health Department from the Minnesota Department of Health remains subject to all applicable rules and statutes, including the Government Data Practices Act, Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 13.
