AMENDED
STANDING ORDER

WHEREAS, Hennepin County Community Corrections has centralized its electronic home monitoring (EHM) program for adults and juveniles on pretrial release and probation;

WHEREAS, Hennepin County Community Corrections follows an EHM Response Grid in determining when to initiate an arrest of a person in violation of EHM supervision rules; and,

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute § 629.355 applies to persons being supervised on EHM.

THEREFORE, THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE THE STANDING ORDER OF THE COURT:

1. Consistent with their EHM Response Grid, the Hennepin County EHM Division Manager or designee is hereby authorized to request law enforcement to take custody of a juvenile being supervised on EHM when there is probable cause to believe that the juvenile has violated EHM rules.
2. The probation officer shall provide a detention report to the court as soon as possible after the arrest. The child shall then appear on the next detention calendar.
3. No juvenile arrested pursuant to this Order may be detained longer than the period provided in rule 5.04, subdivision 2(c), Minnesota Rules of Delinquency Procedure.
