PROCESS TO OBTAIN COPY OF SAFEKEEPING WILL WHEN LATER DATED WILL IS BEING PROBATED

In the event that the Registrar finds an earlier dated Will when an informal application is filed and a later dated Will is being probated use the following procedure to obtain a copy of the earlier Will.

Registrar can give the attorney the Document Number for the safekeeping Will if a death certificate for the decedent has been e-filed in the informal case.

Attorney would take the following steps to obtain a copy of the earlier dated Will:

- Prepare a Petition for a Copy of a Safekeeping Will
- E-file the Petition into the Document Number where the Will is being held (**not into the informal case**)

Court staff will process the petition and request an order from the Judge to release a copy.

Court staff will e-serve the attorney a copy of the order.

If the petition is granted the attorney may request a copy of the earlier dated Will through EFS including the payment of copy fees, making the request in the Document Number (**not in the informal case**). Use the e-filing code – Copy Request

Copy request will go to the Records Center. Since this is a safekeeping Will the records center will not have access to the document and will e-mail the Probate Court to handle the request.

Probate Court staff will make the copy and mail or prepare the copy for pickup.
