ORDER ON RULE 15 PLEA PETITIONS

ORDER

- 1. When parties wish to submit a joint agreement that binds the court to the particulars of the negotiated plea, the parties must approach the judge in advance of the hearing and inquire as to whether the judge is willing to be bound to the terms and conditions of the plea. Parties are not to assume that a judge is willing to be bound to the plea.
- 2. Parties shall include the attached appendix on all plea petitions, regardless of whether the plea is a joint recommendation, joint agreement, or no recommendation.
- 3. Parties shall revise the plea petition to ensure that it accurately details the specifics of the plea before filing with the court. When the plea is a joint recommendation or no recommendation, the language in the plea petition that references a defendant's right to withdraw from the plea and have a trial if the judge does not approve the agreement must be crossed off and initialed or deleted from the petition. A defendant does not have a right to withdraw from a plea on a joint recommendation or no recommendation.
