Comerica filed a copy of the above documents under seal because the filings contain records produced by a third-party that were designated as confidential, and confidential commercial information related to the Estate's finances, entertainment transactions, and estate taxes. Therefore, the Court makes the following:

ORDER

Based upon the confidential nature of the redacted contents of Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A.'s Response to Motion to Approve Fees Requested by Heirs' Representatives; and the entire Exhibits A-Q and S-T to the Declaration of Joseph J. Cassioppi in support thereof, the unredacted versions of the documents may be filed and kept under seal until further order of this

Court. The information qualifies as confidential commercial information under Minn. R. Civ. P. 26.03(g), and there is no historical right of access to the information under the test articulated in *Minneapolis Star & Tribune Co. v. Schumacher*, 392 N.W.2d 197 (Minn. 1986).
