SECOND SPECIAL ADMINISTRATOR'S  
MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT  
SEEKING A REFUND OF THE  
ENTERTAINMENT ADVISORS'  
COMMISSION BASED FEES**

The above-entitled matter came before the Honorable Kevin W. Eide, Judge of District Court on the motion of the Second Special Administrator motion for summary judgment seeking a refund of the former Entertainment Advisors' fees pursuant to Minnesota Statute Section 524.3-721 and Minnesota Rule of Civil Procedure 56. All appearances were as noted on the record. Based upon the submissions of parties, and the proceedings herein:

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**

1. The Second Special Administrator's Motion for Summary Judgment Seeking the Refund of Fees is **GRANTED**.

2. Within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Order, former Estate Entertainment Advisors NorthStar Enterprises Worldwide, Inc. (providing the services of L. Londell McMillan) and CAK Entertainment, Inc. (providing the services of Charles Koppelman) shall refund to the Estate all compensation received as a result of the rescinded UMG transaction.

a. UMG Transaction: CAK and NorthStar shall return the [REDACTED] they collectively received from the rescinded UMG transaction. CAK and NorthStar are jointly and severally liable to the Estate for this sum.

3. Failure to adhere to this Order and return funds within thirty (30) days will result in CAK and NorthStar being held in contempt of court until such time as the refunds are made in full. The Court will not stay enforcement of this Order pending any appeal.

4. There being no just reason for delay, let judgment be entered accordingly.
