7. UMGI and UMGR shall be awarded attorneys' fees, costs, and disbursements

incurred in connection with the motion to quash, pursuant to Minn. R. Civ. P. 45.03(a);

within 28 days of the filing of this order, counsel for UMGI and UMGR shall submit for the

Court's consideration an affidavit to the Court with respect to the reasonable attorneys'

fees and costs incurred in bringing this motion.
