NEW CIVIL CASE TYPE**

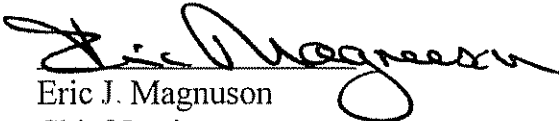
