ORDER

By its order of July 18, 2011, the Special Redistricting Panel (the panel) allowed the parties to request oral argument on the issue of redistricting criteria. The panel ordered that oral argument, if requested, will be heard on Wednesday, October 26, 2011, at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 300 of the Minnesota Judicial Center.
