Dear Judge Eide:

We write on behalf of Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A., in its role as personal representative ("Personal Representative") of the Estate of Prince Rogers Nelson, regarding the first Personal Representative Fee Affidavit and Attorney Fee Affidavit required under the Court's March 22, 2017 Order.

Specifically, the March 22 Order requires the Personal Representative to submit by tomorrow (June 16, 2017) its first Personal Representative Fee Affidavit and Attorney Fee Affidavit covering fees and costs of the Personal Representative from December 2016 through May 31, 2017. The Personal Representative has been diligently working to meet that deadline, but has only recently received invoice and expense records for May 2017 and is still in the process of reviewing those records for attorney-client privilege and confidentiality redactions.

To ensure that the Personal Representative has an adequate time to verify that no confidential information is inadvertently disclosed, the Personal Representative respectfully requests that the Court grant it a one-week extension (to June 23, 2017) to submit its first Personal Representative Fee Affidavit and Attorney Fee Affidavit. Submitted with this letter is a proposed order related to this request.
