The Court recently scheduled a hearing in this matter to be held on February 8, 2017. As with previous hearings, the Court has received requests from the media for permission to bring cameras into the courtroom during the hearing. It is the Court's intent to approve such requests, both for the hearing scheduled for February 8, 2017, and any hearings in the future, unless a party offers a compelling reason not to do so. Therefore, the Court makes the following:

## **ORDER**

1. Any party to the hearing now scheduled for February 8, 2017 on the Petition filed by Phaedra Ellis-Lamkin, may object to cameras being allowed in the Courtroom if the written objection is filed with the Court no later than January 30, 2017. If a written objection is received, it shall be ruled upon by the Court. If no objection is received, cameras will be allowed in the courtroom, subject to coordination with the State Court Information Office and Carver County Court Administration.

2. For all future hearings, it is presumed that cameras shall be allowed in the courtroom, subject to coordination with the State Court Information Office and Carver County Court Administration. If a party objects to the presence of cameras in the courtroom for a particular hearing, they shall notify the Court of the basis of the objection no less than ten days in advance of the hearing. If a written objection is received, it shall be ruled upon by the Court.
