**[PROPOSED] ORDER OF GENERAL
ADMINISTRATION OF ESTATE,
FORMAL ADJUDICATION OF
INTESTACY, DETERMINATION OF
HEIRS, AND APPOINTMENT OF CO-
PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES**

The Joint Petition for General Administration of Estate, Formal Adjudication of Intestacy, Determination of Heirs and Appointment of Co-Personal Representatives, signed by Sharon L. Nelson, Norrine P. Nelson and John R. Nelson (the "Petitioners"), came before this Court on _____. After considering the Petition, the Court determines the following:

1. The Petition is complete. The Petitioners have made oath or affirmation that the statements contained in the Petition are true to the best of the Petitioners' knowledge and belief.
2. At the time of death, the Decedent was domiciled in Carver County at 7801 Audubon Road, Chanhassen, Minnesota, 55317.
3. The Petitioners appear from the Petition to be interested persons as defined by Minnesota law.
4. Based on the statements in the Petition, venue is proper.
5. Any notice required by Minnesota law has been given.
6. The Decedent left no will or other testamentary documents and thus died intestate.
7. The Decedent died on April 21, 2016. Petitioners commenced this proceeding within the time limitations prescribed by Minnesota law.

8. All persons identified as heirs have survived the Decedent by at least 120 hours. The Decedent left no surviving spouse and no surviving descendants.
9. Bremer Trust, National Association (“Bremer”) currently serves as special administrator of the Decedent’s estate. Bremer does not seek appointment as personal representative of the estate.
10. Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A. (“Comerica”) and L. Londell McMillan seek appointment as co-personal representatives.
11. The Petitioners, Alfred Jackson, Tyka Nelson and Omarr J. Baker have equal priority for appointment as personal representative and are not disqualified. The Petitioners have joined in nominating Comerica and L. Londell McMillan to serve as co-personal representatives.
12. The Decedent’s heirs are as identified in the Joint Petition for Determination of Heirs dated July 25, 2016, on file with this Court.
13. There are no objections to the Petition.
14. Comerica, as the corporate personal representative, will have sole custody of all assets of the Decedent’s estate and sole authority for handling receipts and disbursements for the estate.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Petition is granted.
2. The Decedent died intestate.
3. The Decedent’s heirs under Minnesota law are as stated above.
4. Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A. and L. Londell McMillan are formally appointed as the co-personal representatives of the Decedent’s estate, with _____ bond by L. Londell McMillan in a supervised administration.
5. Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A. shall have sole custody of all assets of the Decedent’s estate and sole authority for handling receipts and disbursements for the estate.

6. Letters of General Administration will issue after Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A. and L. Londell McMillan each files a statement of acceptance and oath and posts any required bond.
7. As soon as practicable, Bremer Trust, National Association shall transfer custody of all estate assets to the Comerica Bank & Trust, N.A., as a co-personal representative.
