The above-entitled matter came before the court on March 8, 2017, without a hearing. On March 8, 2017, Omarr Baker and Tyka Nelson filed with the Court the Memorandum in Support of Omarr Baker and Tyka Nelson's Objections to Stinson Leonard Street, LLP's Fee Statements through January 31, 2017, and the Affidavit of Thomas P. Kane in Support of Omarr Baker and Tyka Nelson's Objections to Stinson Leonard Street LLP's Fee Statements Through January 31, 2017 (the "Filings"). Baker and Nelson filed both redacted forms of the Filings and unredacted forms under seal.

Based upon the confidential terms of the court-approved agreements that are not yet finalized and executed and other confidential information in the attorneys' fees invoices, Baker and Nelson requested that the unredacted version of the Filings be filed under seal. Therefore, the Court makes the following:

The financial information relating to confidential agreements qualifies as confidential commercial information under Minnesota Rule of Civil Procedure 26.03(g).
