

STATE OF MINNESOTA IN SUPREME COURT ADM10-8021

ORDER ESTABLISHING PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE MINNESOTA LEGAL SERVICES ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP RULES AND THE RULES RELATING TO DISTRIBUTION OF CIVIL SURCHARGE FUNDS

The Legal Services Advisory Committee (LSAC) filed a petition recommending amendments to the Legal Services Advisory Committee Membership Rules and the Rules Relating to Distribution of Civil Surcharge Funds to: (1) amend the Legal Services Advisory Committee Membership Rules to remove gendered language; (2) remove the definitions that repeat language of Minn. Stat. § 480 et seq. and are not necessary in the court rule; (3) take out language relating to the civil surcharge fee that was repealed in 1990; (4) reference the additional funding that LSAC administers along with the legislative appropriation; (5) allow for per diem compensation of client eligible members on the committee; and (6) repeal the Rules Relating to Distribution of Civil Surcharge Funds as out of date. The court will consider the proposed amendments to the Legal Services Advisory

Committee Membership Rules and the Rules Relating to Distribution of Civil Surcharge

Funds after providing a period for public comment and reviewing any comments on the

proposed amendments.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that any person or organization wishing to provide

written comments in support of or in opposition to the proposed amendments to Legal

Services Advisory Committee Membership Rules and the Rules Relating to Distribution

of Civil Surcharge Funds shall file those comments with the Clerk of the Appellate Courts

using the appellate courts' e-filing application, E-MACS, if required to do so. See Minn.

R. Civ. App. P. 125.01(a). All comments shall be filed so as to be received by the Clerk's

office no later than Monday, March 27, 2023.
