ORDER REGARDING PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULE 5 OF THE GENERAL RULES OF PRACTICE

On January 13, 2020, the Legal Services Advisory Committee (LSAC) filed a petition seeking amendments to Rule 5 of the General Rules of Practice. The committee asks the court to amend Rule 5 by adopting a fee and registration process for out-of-state lawyers who seek pro hac vice admission to appear in Minnesota state courts. We referred LSAC's petition to the Advisory Committee on the General Rules of Practice and the committee's report and recommendations were filed on May 27, 2020. We opened a public comment period and also scheduled a public hearing, on September 15, 2020. Written comments have been filed and one request to speak at the hearing has been filed.

Based on the report, written comments, and requests to speak,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the hearing on September 15, 2020, will begin immediately following the hearing on the petition to amend the Rules of the Supreme Court on Lawyers Registration, will be held remotely, and shall proceed as follows.

1. Randi Ilyse Roth, chair of the Legal Services Advisory Committee shall proceed first and shall have 15 minutes of time to present the committee's petition and the proposed amendments.

- 2. The Honorable Stephen M. Halsey, chair of the Advisory Committee on the General Rules of Practice, shall proceed next and shall have 10 minutes of time to present the report and recommendations of the committee.
- 3. The Clerk of the Appellate Courts is directed to provide instructions to the speakers for a remote hearing conducted via WebEx.
